

SBCA Casino Fundraiser General Information for Volunteering

Casino Location: Cash Casino 4040 Blackfoot Trail SE Calgary
Casino Dates: Thursday, June 8th & Friday June 9th

No experience is required to volunteer for a position at the casino fundraiser. You will be trained by a casino advisor for each position, and most positions require very little work. The casino advisor will be present during the entire casino fundraising event to help us.

Please note that you are allowed to fill more than one timeslot, however, you may only volunteer for the same position during the entire 2 day casino fundraiser.

Dress is business casual.

You have a \$25 tab to cover meals and beverages during your shift.

Free parking is located at the front and along the side of the building. If you require transportation, we recommend you carpool with another person on the same shift.

Volunteers must adhere to the following rules:

- No gambling is allowed at the Casino anytime during the entire 2 day casino fundraiser event.
- No consumption of alcohol or cannabis prior to, during, or after your shift.
- Photo ID must be presented to the casino advisor prior to starting your shift

General Manager

The General Manager works in the cash cage. They are required to oversee the cashiers and fill in any positions that may become vacant. They work with the casino employees to start up tables and close with the final count.

Cashier

The cashiers work in the cash cage. They are responsible for counting chips people bring in and give out corresponding cash. The casino advisor will train you on exactly what is required, and will be overseeing the cashiers the entire time.

Banker

The banker works in the cash cage and opens the float for the cashiers. The casino advisor will train and guide you the entire time.

Chip Runner

The chip runners are located in a quiet back room with couches and are not allowed in the cash cage. They are called upon by the casino via phone to run chips from the cash cage to tables on the floor. Bring a book, cards or craft to work on. You spend most of your time waiting to be called to run chips.

Count Room

The count room volunteers will do a pre-count of money from tables at 11:00p.m. Another count is done at around 1:00 a.m. And a final count is done once the casino has closed. Only while you are counting money is when you are in the count room. The remainder of the time is spent at the restaurant or in the lounge.
