- The shifts are broken down into 2-week increments. (<u>click here to signup</u>)
 If it doesn't snow during your shift, you don't need to do anything.
 *Everyone who signs up for a snow clearing shift will be entered for a chance to WIN a \$150 Meal Voucher (draw date TBD, but once the snow stops, so like June...ish)
- Please clear snow within 48 hours of snowfall or just before an activity/use of the hall, whichever is sooner. (click here to check hall website calendar for hall usage)
- Here are the areas that need to be cleared. (Click here to download snow clearing map)
 - 1. Main Entrance & Steps & Concrete pad
 - 2. Ramp
 - 3. 4ft wide walkway from Ramp to Side Entrance to Kitchen Entrance
 - 4. Side Entrance
 - 5. Kitchen Entrance & Steps
 - 6. South Entrance (back side of building) Clear steps and doorway
 - 7. Disabled parking stall (all other parking areas are cleared by Foothills County)
 - 8. Clear 6ft x 6ft area on west side of fence by black hall sign so we can change the letters on the sign (the sign swings around)
- All equipment is at the hall. We have snow shovels, a 12inch electric snow blower (for the path) and grit.
